02/21/2023

Meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM by Dan Nelson, President.

Devotions were shared by Roger.

The minutes of the 01/17/2023 meeting were reviewed by the council. One change was made to update the attendees to include Karen Donahue. Roger made a motion to approve the minutes with the addition, Jennifer seconded, and the minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report was provided by Debbie Wendt. The Profit & Loss statement and the Balance Sheet were reviewed by the council. A discussion was held regarding the Housing Allowance line on the budget. Gold Pot offering from January was rounded up to \$250 to Faith Covenant.

Pastor's Report – N/A

Unfinished Business – Roger reported on the options for the southwest door to replace the latch for easy exit from the building in case of emergency. Approximate cost is \$90 for the latch. Julie motioned to replace the latch. Megan seconded. Approved.

Megan is going to check with I-serve for a quote on cleaning the areas in the church with tile and see if they have suggestions for carpet cleaning services.

A discussion was held regarding a computer for a pastor to use and a computer to project the PowerPoint presentation. Purchasing a computer is tabled until discussions are held with the potential interim pastor.

New Business – Interim may be available the middle of March. Supply pastors are arranged through March 26, 2023.

Interim salary – Dan will set up a meeting with the potential interim to gather preliminary information for salary discussions. Dede agreed to participate in that initial discussion.

6% ELCA Offering Deferment – A request by a church member was made at the annual meeting for an opportunity that individuals' contributions could be excluded from the 6% donation to ELCA. After discussion, a motion was made by Megan that members be allowed to exclude their contributions from the 6% calculation that is currently in place regarding contributions to ELCA/Central States Synod. Those members would contact Marcia Mathias to request the exclusion. The motion was seconded and approved. Dan will communicate with Marcia and Debbie will adjust contributions to ELCA as needed.

Two light bulbs need to be replaced in the sanctuary. A discussion of LED vs standard, dimmable bulbs was held. Roger will research options.

The Central States Synod Mission Support publication was shared with the council. This publication provides understanding of how the ELCA/Central States Synod uses St Paul's contributions.

The next meeting is March 14, 2023 at 6:00 PM. Dede will provide devotions.
