St Paul Council Minutes 3/14/2023

Members Present: Julie Albrecht, Karen Donahue, Roger Engle, Megan Mein, Dan Nelson, Dede Patterson, Jennifer Wilson

President Dan Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm.

The meeting was opened with devotions provided by Dede.

The minutes of the 02/21/2023 council meeting were read. Dan motioned for approval, Julie seconded. The minutes were approved as read.

Financials – Debbie was absent so no details were discussed. Dan proposed Lutheran Campus Ministry for March gold pot offering. Discussion was held regarding the 03/13/2023 meeting with Bishop Susan Candea, Associate Bishop Dave Whetter, Hebron council members, and St Paul council members. The discussion focused on whether the current budget for a pastor's salary would be adequate to cover the expenses for a combination resident pastor and transition consultant.

Pastor's Report - N/A

Unfinished Business

Carpet Cleaning – Megan did not have an update on cleaning the areas in the church with tile or suggestions for carpet cleaning services. The individual at IServe was out of the office when she attempted to contact them for a bid.

Door Latch – Roger reported the new latch for the southwest door has been installed. This is to allow for easy exit from the building in case of emergency. Keys are in the key safe in the office.

Lights in sanctuary – Roger reported that research revealed that LED lights are expensive and they are not conducive to being enclosed in a globe.

The church will continue to use standard bulbs for the sanctuary lights.

LYO Bank Account – Dan indicated that Andrea will confirm the balance and the council will determine how best to handle the money.

New Business – Holy Week – Dan will contact Bishop Candea to engage Pastor Jim Peters for Palm Sunday, Hebron – Maundy Thursday, St Paul – Good Friday and Easter Sunday as pulpit supply. Times for evening services are still to be determined.

Sound system – Microphones are not consistently picking up the presiding ministers' voices. Dan stated Dale Diepenbrock is looking into the microphone function.

Pastor Jim Peters' Status – After Holy Week, the church could consider him for pulpit supply for a short time or for the resident pastor position for a possible six months term.

Financial Position of the Church – The question was posed as to the appropriateness of the property insurance for the church. It was clarified that the current insurance policy covers the church and the parsonage. The current policy is through 12/12/2023. The council tabled discussions or possible reduction of the coverage on the church until later in the year closer to the renewal date.

After Prom Requests for Donations – Megan motioned that a \$50 donation be given to both Herington High School and Hope High School for a total of \$100. Roger seconded. All approved.

Tri-County Free Fair Request for Support Donation – Megan motioned no support donation be given and instead a booth rental would be considered. Dan seconded. All approved.

The next meeting will be April 18, 2023 at 6:00 PM. Karen will provide devotions.
